Martin Martinez-Ripoll, PhD in Chemistry from the University Complutense of Madrid. He spent three years (2005-2008) as Vice-President for International Affairs of the Spanish National Research Council (CSIC). During the three previous years (2003-2005) he occupied the position of Director of the CSIC's Postgraduate Department. Some years before (1993-2000) he was elected Advisor for the CSIC's Chemistry Area and Advisor of the CSIC's Scientific Committee. He also spent three years (1992-1995) as Vice-Director of the Institute of Physical-Chemistry "Rocasolano", CSIC. In May 2008 he went back to his original research position at the Department of Crystallography & Structural Biology at the Institute of Physical-Chemistry "Rocasolano".

As a Postdoc he spent four years in Germany as an Alexander von Humboldt Fellow and under a contract of the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG) working at the Institute of Chemistry of the University of Freiburg. As a CSIC's Research Professor he is (and has been) working for many years in chemical crystallography and structural biology, leading during twenty years the Department of Crystallography & Structural Biology at the Institute of Physical-Chemistry "Rocasolano", the most ancient research institute of the CSIC. He has contributed to over 240 peer-reviewed publications in international journals.
